RIVER ANGLING Upper Lowland River Coarse and Fly *plus Gabriels*

Primarily a river fishing society, RTWAS stretches are on the upper Medway from Hartfield downstream to Poundsbridge, plus Teston and including the noted Ashurst and Fordcombe stretches. We have 3 ponds at Buxted Park, plus we have a limited free arrangement with Gabriels Fishery Edenbridge to fish their complex of lakes for Carp and many species all year, and Gabriels stretch of the upper River Eden in season. We also control a stretch of the Eden above Vexour Bridge. There are Barbel to 14lb plus, Chub 7lb plus, Perch to 4lb, Large Pike, River Carp to 32lb plus, with Roach over 2lb and Dace and the odd surprise to be discovered when you visit the different RTWAS venues. Small Grayling and native Brown Trout on our higher Medway stretch in the fly season. RTWAS is a small friendly society for discerning anglers, with a limited membership on 9 miles of river all in fine Kent & Sussex countryside.

There are DANGEROUS steep riverbanks and access with DEEP WATER. Characterised by steep grassy banks, which can be muddy, slippery, and even more so when icy or wet, RTWAS venues are not suitable for the young, the infirm, or those uncomfortable on challenging slopes. There are also deep water stretches and deep holes to be wary of. Be sure to read our Health and Safety guidelines for your personal safety on our dangerous banks.

No member under 16 years old may fish at any time without an adult society member with them.

Highlighted Rules of RTWAS:

- A. No Bivvies
- B. No Unattended Rods beyond arms reach
- C. Members under 16 years must be accompanied on all waters by an adult society member
- D. Night Fishing not available to Members under 18 years
- E. Guest Tickets not available in the first year of membership and only available from August to March
